

## Summer 2025

Thank you for your interest in volunteering for Camp Exclamation Point (CAMP!), a week-long residential summer camp for underserved rural Vermont kids, which takes place in Thetford, VT. We offer a core program of experiences and activities in art and music, natural science, physical activity, water safety, nutrition and hygiene, and literacy. It is a safe and welcoming environment for kids to be kids, where good citizenship is modeled and encouraged, and we empower children to make meaningful personal decisions, learn responsibility and build their self-esteem. CAMP! strives to be a stable and rewarding experience that our campers enjoy returning for each summer, and to make this experience available to their siblings.

Camp Exclamation Point, Inc. is a non-profit organization that operates on funds generated through grants and donations. As a result, most camp staff positions are volunteer-based. Staff members receive room, board, and a camp T-shirt for the time they are with us. Beyond that, our rewards come from knowing we have provided a week of summer camp to children whose families might otherwise be unable to afford to send them. Donations and gifts-in-kind are always appreciated.

Volunteers serve in a variety of positions, with new staff primarily filling roles as counselors, waterfront staff (certified lifeguards are especially in need), and members of our kitchen team.

For our new volunteers, camp begins with staff orientation and training on Friday, August 8th, with arrival between 4 and 5pm. Campers arrive on Sunday the 10th. We will depart after clean-up on Saturday, August 16th, around 2pm. Volunteers are asked to be present for this entire period of time.

If you are interested in applying to volunteer for a week of working with other amazing individuals to provide an excellent summer experience for children, here is what you need to do first: Complete the staff application, which is included in this letter. When I receive your application, I will be in touch with you by phone or e-mail to arrange a time to speak by phone. At that time, we will talk about our program, the various positions we are looking to fill on staff, and how your skills and experience may fit into our camp family. We will also go over any other questions you or I may have.

Please note that all staff members (and campers) may be asked to take a COVID-19 test (antigen or PCR) prior to arriving at camp.
